## Welcome Alex Baczewski, Assistant Director of Bands (Lowery Freshman Campus)

Alex Baczewski is a saxophonist and will be joining Allen High School as Assistant Director of Bands at the Lowery Freshman Campus. Mr. Baczewski will be directing the LFC Symphonic Band, LFC Concert Band I and will assist with the LFC Wind Ensemble, Escadrille, and other ensembles at AHS. Mr. Baczewski currently serves as an Associate Instructor in the Department of Bands at the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music where he is pursuing a Master of Music degree in Wind Conducting. He holds a Bachelor of Music Education Degree from Baylor University. Mr. Baczewski served for three years as Associate Director of Bands at Decker Middle School in the Austin area where he founded the Decker Jazz Band and was instrumental in helping the Decker Honor Band to earn UIL Sweepstakes for the first time in school history. While teaching, Mr. Baczewski was a performing member of the Cedar Park Winds.

## Welcome Jeremy Rohr, Assistant Director of Bands (Allen High School)

Mr. Rohr will continue his duties in Allen ISD as he will be joining the band faculty at AHS. Mr. Rohr will be directing the AHS Symphonic Band II and AHS Concert Band II as well as being responsible for AHS lockers, Region Band entries, and Solo & Ensemble entries.

### **REQUIRED JACKET PURCHASE FOR 2019-2020**

All students in the Escadrille will be required to wear standard wet weather/cold weather jackets. Color Guard will have their assigned attire (please address questions to Mr. Singletary). If the weather is wet or extremely cold and you do not have the proper jacket, you will be dismissed at inspection and receive a "zero" for not participating. We will not have ponchos available for students that forget their required attire.

Woodwinds, brass, and percussion will be required to wear one of the following for cold or wet weather:

- 1. Senior Letterman Jacket (Official AHS Jacket) this can be band or another AHS activity (as they are the same jacket).
- 2. Plain/Solid (no writing, images, markings), Navy jacket (hoodie, raincoat, etc). The color must be dark navy. Not royal blue. Must be free of any markings. You can purchase these on your own at any store (Target, Walmart, etc). A HOOD is recommended.
- 3. **Recommended**: Approved Allen Band Jacket available for purchase from the Allen Band Booster Association (ABBA). The jacket is water resistant and has a hood perfect for cold or wet weather. The jackets will be \$54 and you can PERSONALIZE your jacket (name, instrument, etc) for \$64. While this is not a required item (you can purchase a jacket on your own), you are encouraged to purchase this item from ABBA. Please enter the building from the Performing Arts Center (PAC) doors. We cover rehearsal schedules, football game procedures, U.I.L. eligibility, financial commitments, and much more. The parent meeting will be led by Mr. Joshua Blankenship (Director of Bands Lowery Freshman Center) and Dr. Philip Obado (Director of Bands Allen ISD). The student meeting will be led by Mr. Alex Baczewski (Assistant Director of Bands, Lowery Freshman Center) and Chris Cammarata, President of the Allen Band Council. These meetings are specifically for incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders or any other student who is new to Allen I.S.D. and our band program. We look forward to seeing you all there!

## STUDENT LEADERS ONLY - July 22-24 (8a-4p)/July 25-26 (8a-11a)

All <u>Student Leadership Team members</u> will be trained on these three days. Manny Maldonado from SASI: The Leadership People (<u>www.studentsleading.org</u>) will lead a seminar for all SLTs on July 22 and 23. Attendance is required; please contact Dr. Obado if you have any issues. We will combine leadership sessions, teaching workshops, and work sessions on July 24th to prepare for the full band on July 25<sup>th</sup>. We will have additional SLT work days on July 25-26 in the mornings of full band rehearsal.

# <u>FULL BAND SUMMER REHEARSALS – Thursday, July 25<sup>th</sup> – Tuesday, August 14<sup>th</sup></u> All rehearsals will take place at Allen High School

Attendance at summer rehearsals is required of all members. The schedule from July 29-August 2 is 7:00a-4:00p each day with lunch between 11:00a-12:00p. For the most part, we will be marching outdoors in the morning and will be indoors after lunch. The schedule from August 5-August 12 is 3:00p-8:00p (Aug 13 is 1pm-7pm with the Premiere Show beginning at 6pm). Please follow the attached calendar for your specific report days and times. Please bring your lunch during summer band. Because the physical nature of our activity, students must adhere to the following guidelines: wear lightweight comfortable clothing, tennis shoes w/socks (refrain from no-show socks to avoid blisters), sunscreen, baseball caps/visors, and above all bring plenty of WATER every day. You will be expected to have and carry your own ½ gallon water jug to all band activities including football games and band contests. These jugs can be purchased at various retail stores. ## ESCADRILLE REGISTRATION DAY – Saturday, July 27th (REQUIRED) Allen High School

Registration Day is intended for all members of the Band. It is designed as a "One-Stop-Shop" for students and parents participating in the Escadrille. Uniforms, music, instruments, and equipment will be issued at this time. Permission slips and contact information will be completed and all required fees collected. Apparel, yard signs, and other optional spirit items will also be available. Parents are encouraged to join the Allen Band Booster Association and to sign up as volunteers for many band events. Parent support plays a vital role in the success of our students so please make plans to join us on this important day. Please refer to the registration day document for further details.

## ALLEN ESCADRILLE FAN FEST - Friday, August 2nd

Watters Creek performance @ 7pm

After rehearsal gets out, we will have a short break before the band leaves for Watters Creek. We will leave AHS at 6pm and bus to Watters Creek. We will parade around Watters Creek beginning at 6:30p for a performance on the Green beginning at 7pm and concluding at 8pm. Students can be picked up at Watters Creek (with the appropriate paperwork) or can ride back after the performance.

### **SUMMER BAND REHEARSALS & MARCHING BAND TIER SYSTEM**

Attendance at summer band rehearsals is critical. We understand that there are family trips and other conflicts that happen during the summer months. While there are no grade consequences for absences and tardies, summer rehearsal attendance can directly affect a student's spot. Spots are assigned based on three things: (1) Band placement at AHS/LFC (placements were already assigned based on audition in Spring 2019), (2) marching technique evaluated by directors at summer rehearsals, and (3) attendance at summer rehearsals. Please note that students will miss critical information for any kind of absence. "Excused" or "Unexcused" absences do not matter; your spot depends on your positive attendance.

What is the tier system? Students will be assigned spots in one of four tiers. The top performing tier is Tier 1, Tier 2 is the next level of students, Tier 3 is next, and the final tier will be our Reserve Block. While all four tiers will have spots in the Traditional Show, only students in Tiers 1-3 will have spots in the Contest Show. Students in the reserve block will have separate Contest Show drill and will perform at every football game in the end zones. While the reserve block will not march at our three contests, they will play an important support role for the band; their attendance is required. Reserves will perform at every football game for the entire season.

## **BACK-TO-SCHOOL GENERAL INFO**

Beginning on the second day of school (Thursday, August 15), all daily marching rehearsals will begin at 7:00 a.m. each morning at the AHS Track Stadium. Freshmen will be dismissed and bused to LFC around 8:15 a.m. each morning. We will no longer have Monday Night rehearsals.



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## **ATHLETICS**

Athletes, we have had great success working and scheduling with coaches to give you the opportunity to participate in both marching band and athletics. We will continue tweaking this project on an individual basis, with regards to the sport in which each student is participating.

Your student leaders are planning fun social activities scattered throughout summer band. Take some time to get acclimated to the heat and exercise by getting off the couch and into the great outdoors once in a while. It's going to be another GREAT YEAR!

<u>The Band Dri-Fit Shirt</u> is worn when the full uniform is not necessary or appropriate. Students will be asked to wear their band Dri-Fit shirt with blue jeans or khaki shorts (khaki shorts preferred). **All band members are required to purchase a Dri-Fit Shirt for the 2019-2020 school year.** 

<u>The Blue Uniform Undershirt</u> is a part of the formal marching band uniform. Since this will not change, you may continue using the same shirt if it is still in good shape and fits year after year.

<u>The Band Athletic Shorts</u> are our customized Nike running shorts suitable for wearing underneath our uniform at all times.

<u>UIL/Game Day Refreshments:</u> The band provides snacks and meals throughout the marching season.

<u>Uniform Cleaning</u>: The band provides cleaning for the marching uniform throughout the season and one concert uniform cleaning at the end of the concert season.


<u>Ultimate Drill Book & App:</u> Students will be provided a drill book specifically for their spot as well as a license for an online app.

## **School Owned Instrument Fee:**

The following AISD owned instruments *require* a usage fee: Percussion, Oboe, Bassoon, Bass Clarinet, Tenor Saxophone, Bari Saxophone, Horn/Mellophone, Bass Trombone, Euphonium & Tuba. The current instrument usage fee is \$125.00 per year and covers only *part* of the yearly cleaning each instrument receives or in the case of percussion, general upkeep and drumhead replacement.

## Music & Arts:

Representatives from Music & Arts will be on site to provide students with general supply needs for purchase (flip folders, extra flip folder windows, valve oil, reeds, lyres etc). Students who do not own a flip folder should purchase one (along with extra pages) on or before registration day. **Payment for these purchases should be made payable directly to Music & Arts.**
