#### • DUNCANVILLE MARCHING INVITATIONAL: SAT. OCT 26

Call time for the Duncanville Marching Invitational is 10:30am – approximate return time is 11:45pm. We ask that students eat a light breakfast before call time. We will have Chick-Fil-A Chicken biscuits for lunch after morning rehearsal, snacks for our after our performance, and Rudys for dinner prior to Finals. We will stay to watch bands if we do not advance to finals.

A note on reserves/compline @ contests: All members of the band are required to participate in contests. The reserves will work with a director during rehearsal and during contest warm-up. They will talk about the process, possibly help with props, set-up, and work on focus/discipline routines while the rest of the band is rehearsing. During the performance, the reserve block will stand at set on the front sideline. While this may appear unessential on the surface, this is how the entire band will show their support to their peers. The main objective for the reserve block and Comp Line is to observe and reflect on the contest environment (even though they are not performing) and learn from watching the performances of other bands. Reserves and Comp Line students are held to the same attendance standards as the contest show block/Marching Line. Refer to the band handbook regarding attendance policies.

#### WHAT HAPPENS WITH MONRING REHEARSALS AFTER THE LAST MARCHING CONTEST?

We will reduce marching band rehearsals to one day a week – the same day we have a football game. We will continue this into the playoffs. Eventually, we will eliminate morning rehearsals. 1<sup>st</sup> period bands at AHS and LFC will begin sectionals and full band rehearsals before school. The director for each 1<sup>st</sup> period ensemble will dictate their sectional/full band schedule. No band should begin anything before 7:50am. 8<sup>th</sup> Period Band rehearsals may have after-school rehearsals or sectionals. Note that most students will only have a sectional once a week and not all ensembles 8<sup>th</sup> period will have after-school sectionals.
