PLAYOFF GAME #2: AREA PLAYOFF VS. ROCKWALL (FRIDAY @ AT&T STADIUM)

Please see the itinerary below for our second playoff game of the season vs. Rockwall this Friday at AT&T Stadium. This is a much different schedule as there are few factors on Friday: (1) It's an early release day. Students should go home and come back. If that is a challenge, the Band Hall will be open. (2) It will be a late game at AT&T Stadium. There are a lot of logistical concerns at AT&T so there is a lot of padded time. (3) It might rain Friday afternoon – the itinerary has two options based on rain affecting afternoon rehearsal. We will make a decision by the end of the school day on Thursday, Nov 21 via Charms e-mail & Text.

PLAYOFF GAME FOOTBALL/ATTENDANCE @ GAMES

We now begin the last part of the marching season: playoff football. Traditionally, we play two to three Friday night games, then move to Saturday afternoons. Attendance at games is required since we are a part of the game day experience. While we require the games, please know that we understand that there may have been previously scheduled events in the next few weeks. PLEASE COMMUNICATE NOW IF YOU ANTICIPATE CONFLICTS. Some excusable conflicts include family events (given notice at least a month in advance), SAT/ACT, and Region Band tryouts. If you are not going to be in town during Thanksgiving weekend (Nov. 29-30), please fill out the excused absence request form now. We need to reserve transportation and meals and we need to know numbers on a weekly basis. ANY ABSENCE REQUESTS WITH LESS THAN 7 DAYS NOTICE (OTHER THAN ILLNESS COMMUNICATED BY PARENTS) WILL BE CONSIDERED UNEXCUSED.

GAMEDAY REMINDERS: ETTIQUITE IN STANDS/EARLY CHECK-OUT

- (1) Your performance and behavior in the stands is a direct reflection of yourself, the band program, Allen ISD, and City of Allen. Always represent class with your actions and how you play/sound in the stands.
- (2) Please refer to the handbook for details on how to check-out of games early. ALL STUDENTS STAY THE ENTIRE GAME SINCE WE ARE A PART OF THE ENTIRE GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE NOBODY LEAVES AFTR HALFTIME. We have a job to do at all games; football players/cheerleaders don't leave after halftime. If you are leaving early, you may leave at the end of the game. You also need a parent and two copies of the AISD District form: Alternate Means of Travel (one for your bus chaperone and another to a director with your parent when you check-out at the conclusion of the game).
